With deep respect and emotion, we bid farewell to our dear comrade Shri Reghu N, Deputy General Secretary (Head Quarters) and CWC Secretary, who retired from the service of the Bank and our Union on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2025.

Born on 17<sup>th</sup> May 1965 to Late Shri. Narayana Pillai and Smt. Sarojini Amma, Com. Reghu N grew up in PTP Nagar, Thiruvananthapuram. He studied at Govt. Model High School, Thycaud and later completed his pre-degree and graduation from Govt. Arts College and M.G. College, Thiruvananthapuram.

He joined the Bank in 1990 at Ponganadu Branch, and went on to serve at many important offices including Zonal Office Trivandrum, NRI Branch, RACPC, and RBO-II, Thiruvananthapuram. His final posting was at Local Head Office, Trivandrum.

Com. Reghu N played a major role in our union throughout his career. He served as Regional Secretary (Zone-I), Vice President of our Thiruvananthapuram Sub-Office, and was made Assistant General Secretary (Zone-II) during the critical time of the e-AB merger in 2017.
