It is with great respect and warm wishes that we bid farewell to our beloved comrade Shri. Radhakrishnan N, Deputy General Secretary of Thrissur Sub Office, who retired from the Bank and our Union on 31st May, 2025, after years of dedicated and inspiring service.

Com. Radhakrishnan was born in the peaceful village of Kolathur, Nellore, to Late Shri. K. Sankunni Nair, a proud ex-serviceman, and Late Smt. N. Sarojini, a respected teacher. From his early days, he imbibed strong values of discipline, honesty, and service to society.

He began his education at Don Bosco School and G.V.B.H.S., Kodakara, and continued his pre-degree studies at St. Thomas College, Thrissur and acquired graduation in BSc.
